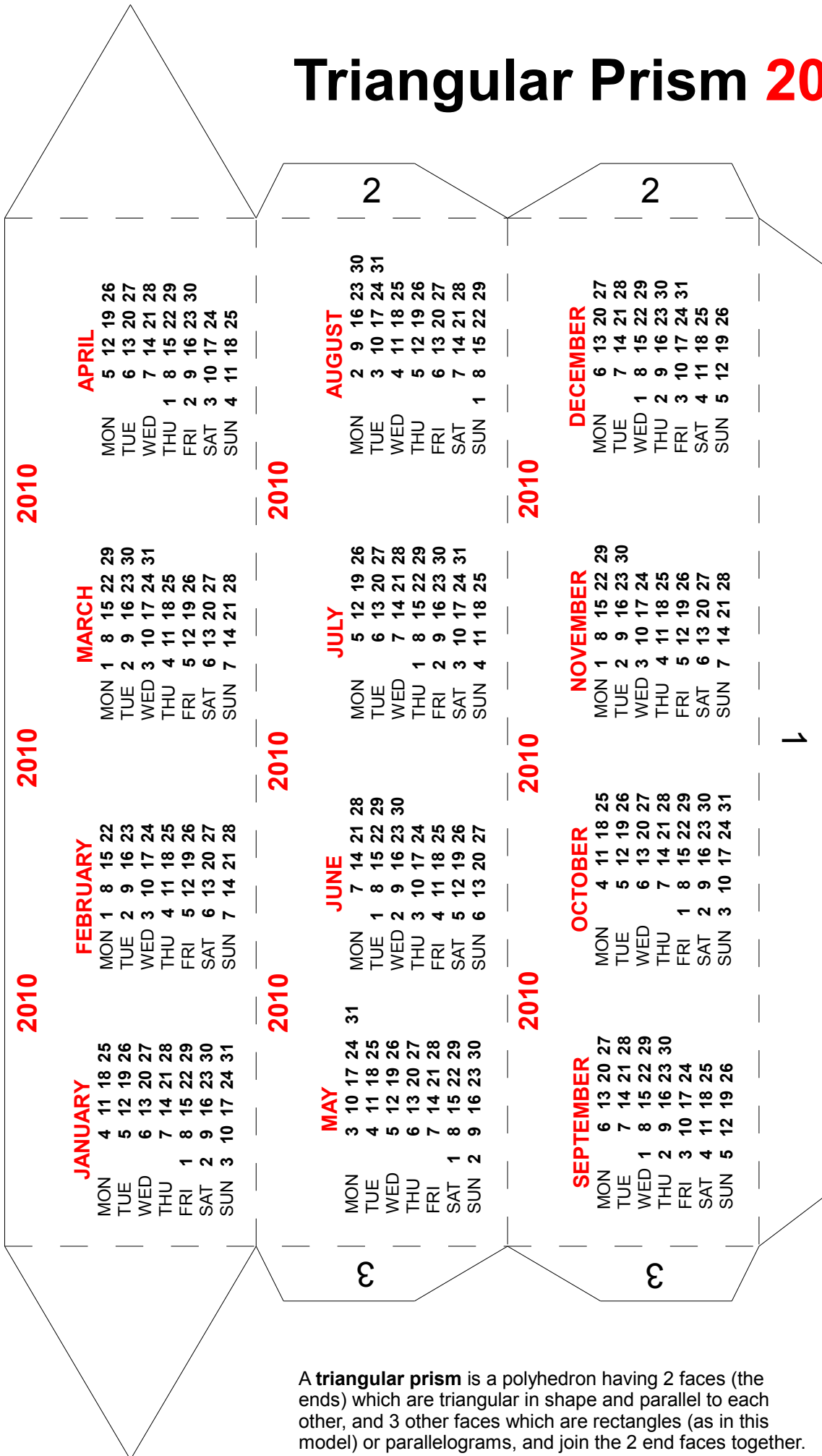


Triangular Prism 2010



A **triangular prism** is a polyhedron having 2 faces (the ends) which are triangular in shape and parallel to each other, and 3 other faces which are rectangles (as in this model) or parallelograms, and join the 2 end faces together.

To make

Cut out along all the 'solid' lines and fold along the broken lines. Glue the tabs in the order they are numbered. The use of a ruler is useful when gluing tab 1. Make sure the calendar appears on the outside of the shape being made!

For best results

Use sharp scissors and cut carefully. Lightly score all broken lines before folding. Roughly fold it up into position (without glue) so as to have a clear idea of how it will look.

Use a good glue, don't put too much on, and make sure each tab is secure before doing the next. Where two tabs have the same number, glue them all at the same time.
